HealthConnection Clinic reaches its one year anniversary!

Why a clinic?

The North Shore has over 3, 000 high needs people who do not have regular access to primary care. These people end up utilizing the Emergency Department, walk in clinics for their primary care needs, or leave their medical needs unattended. HealthConnection Clinic aims to fill this service gap.

Since opening our

doors in July 2013, the clinic has had over 1144 visits, serving 237 unique clients. The clinic is staffed by a multidisciplinary team, meaning clients can have their medical and social needs met in the same visit. For example, clients are able to access a GP, and then see an outreach worker from a community agency that can assist them with housing issues.

The relaxed nature of the clinic has created an inviting and warm space for clients. Clients have expressed their appreciation of the space and the great care that they are receiving from the clinic.





The clinic is having a positive impact on the acute health care system

Between July 2nd, 2013 and June 30th, 2014, the clinic saw...

Emergency Department visits decrease by 7.1%

Hospital Admissions decrease by 38.5%

Average Length of Stay in hospital decrease from 12.2 to 4.7 days


Percentage of Alternative Level of Care Days decrease from 13.5% to 0.0%
