New Infant/Child Vaccine Products

Please be advised that there have recently been some product substitutions made in the infant/child immunization program. Below is a chart to assist you in choosing the correct product for the child presenting for immunization. Please phone the Public Health nurse on call at 604-983-6700 if you have questions about which product to use.

DTaP-IPV- Hib-HB	Infanrix- hexa™ (GSK)	Infanrix-hexa™ (GSK) No replacement	Primary series at 2, 4 and 6 months of age. Not a product change but a refor primary infant series.	Primary series for children ≤ 6 years of age and as a booster when hepatitis B indicated eminder that this is the product
DTaP-IPV- HiB	Pediacel® (Sanofi Pasteur)	Infanrix-IPV-HiB® (GSK)	Primary series at 2, 4 and 6 months of age only when hepatitis B <i>not</i> indicated Booster at 18 months of age	Primary series for children < 6 years of age and as a booster when hepatitis B <i>not</i> indicated.
DTaP-IPV	Quadracel® (Sanofi Pasteur)	Infanrix-IPV® (GSK)	Preferred choice for school entry kindergarten booster starting at 4 years of age	Primary series completion and booster for children < 6 years of age in whom HIB and Hepatitis B are not indicated
Products for	Patients 7 years	of age and older		
Tdap	Adacel® (Sanofi Pasteur)	Boostrix® (GSK)	Reinforcing dose in grade 9	Primary series completion for age 7 and older when only these antigens indicated.
Tdap-IPV	Adacel-polio® (Sanofi Pasteur)	Boostrix-IPV® (GSK)	Primary and booster for previously unimmunized children ≥ 7 years of age, adolescents and adults when polio also indicated	Alternative choice kindergarten booster when DTaP-IPV (Infanrix-IPV®, Quadracel®) product is unavailable. Tdap-IPV and separate Tdap and IPV are interchangeable.
